Here is one of my web pages: a Things To Do listing. There are still two bugs in it that I am working on: dates are in my home's timezone (rather than the user's timezone), and single quotes in data entries cause exceptions. This is not yet ready for production, but still is being tested. I would like anyone to visit the site and give me feedback on it. <https://ttd.webredirect.org> is a link that will take you to it. It generates a list of tasks and stores them in a MySQL database. The URL points to my home computer. I serve web pages with APACHE. I also serve files (with SAMBA) and ssh. These latter two can only be accessed from within my home WiFi, but the web pages are accessible across the internet. If any one knows about APACHE security, I would like to chat with them (offline???).
